Homework

You can find your child's username and password for both Reading Eggspress and Doodle Maths in their HASP Book.

English

To help your child at home with their English this term, you could do the following:

- Read and discuss the Talk for Writing model texts.
- Ask your child to 'talk the text' for the model texts using the text maps.
- Remind your child to use capital letters at the start of their sentences and proper nouns.
- Help your child to punctuate the end of their sentences with a full stop, exclamation mark or question mark and understand the difference between these.
- Help your child to understand and use commas in a list.
- Help your child to extend their sentences using conjunctions such as 'and', 'but', 'so' & 'because'.
- Help your child to write past tense verbs ending in the suffix -ed.
- Ensure your child regularly uses Reading Eggs(press), including practising spelling via the 'Spelling' section (Reading Eggs) and the 'English Skills' section (Reading Eggspress).

Text maps will be sent via Class Dojo at the start of each Talk for Writing English unit.

Maths

To help your child at home with their Maths this term, you could practise the following:

- Rapidly recalling number bonds to **10** (e.g. 7+3), **20** (e.g. 15+5) and **100** (e.g. 40+60).
- Recalling addition and subtraction facts within 20.
- Rapidly recalling doubles and halves.
- Adding three one-digit numbers.
- Recognising and knowing the value of British coins
- Recognising and knowing the value of British notes.
- Counting amounts of money, including both coins and notes.
- Selecting coins and notes to make a given value.
- Finding the difference between two amounts.
- Working out change.
- Counting in equal groups of 2, 3, 5 and 10.
