Reading

We will continue to develop our fluency, prosody and automaticity in reading lessons alongside comprehension.

Science

We will be learning about different types of rocks, their appearance and properties. We will also be looking at how fossils and soil are formed.

English

We will use the book, The Firework Maker's Daughter, to inspire our writing. We will create a number of different writing pieces linked to this book and our learning in topic lessons and finish the fiction unit creating a journey narrative. A persuasive letter will be created for our non-fiction writing.

Maths

We will be developing knowledge of the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. We will then move onto the formal method for multiplication and a range of strategies for division (2 digit by 1-digit numbers) with numbers linked to the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. In flashback arithmetic, we will continue to revisit prior learning.

DT

In design and technology, we will have the opportunity to evaluate, design and programme wearable technology products using computers. We will also develop point of sale designs.

Geography

Year 3 will be learning about the structure of the Earth, volcanoes and earthquakes. We will be looking at how and where volcanoes and earthquakes occur and the impact they both have on the people living nearby.
