Year 3 Trip to National Roman Legion Museum – Thursday 5th February 2026

The Year 3 teachers have arranged a day trip to the National Roman Legion Museum at Caerleon, Newport, as part of our history topic on Romans. The day will include:-

- A visit to National Roman Legion Museum including the chance to explore the real Roman collections in the gallery.
- Access to the reconstructed Barrack Room at the museum where pupils will have the opportunity to try on replica Roman armour and see how Roman soldiers lived.
- A facilitated workshop with one of our costumed Roman teachers at the museum. In our Medicus session, pupils have the chance to experience Roman medicine! Come and meet our Roman medic who can diagnose and treat your injuries and ailments. Be careful though, they're not always helpful treatments!
- A visit to the real Roman Baths where Romans washed and socialised nearly two thousand years ago.
- A visit to the outdoor Amphitheatre & Barracks sites. Caerleon's Amphitheatre used to hold 6000 people and is the most complete Amphitheatre in Britain! After seeing the reconstructed Barrack Room at the museum, you can see the real thing – Caerleon has the only legionary barracks still on view in Europe!

The cost
